Both clubs meet after school. Meeting dates will be listed on our online Activities Calendar at [www.mqaschool.org](http://www.mqaschool.org) and on PowerSchool's Daily School Bulletin. Committing to this team means your son/daughter will practice the spelling words at home and come to the after-school practice sessions.
