Students in grades 6, 7, and 8 are eligible to participate at the regional level in the Western PA Spelling Bee. Students meet one day a week after school with Mrs. Orłowski to practice the spelling lists that they have been given. At the beginning of February, an elimination round will be held to determine the school champion, who will represent MQA at the annual Western PA Spelling. The winner of that bee will receive an all-expense paid trip to the National Spelling Bee in Washington, D.C.
