Feeding the Body, Mind & Soul

Each month the SMM food bank gives the children of our clients from age 1 through Grade 5 a birthday bag to celebrate their birthday.

Through the generous donations of our parishioners, we provide everything they need for a party (cake mix, icing, plates, cups, utensils, and party treats) plus a gift of two books in the hope of fostering a love of reading.

Unfortunately, our book supply has run short. If you would like to donate a book for one of our Food Bank children, it would be greatly appreciated. The children look forward to their Birthday Bag every year!

If you are interested in donating a book for the Birthday Bags, we ask that you please purchase a new, unused copy of your favorite book, appropriate for your grade level. You can add a little handwritten note on the inside of the book such as "Happy Birthday from your friend at MQA School, Grade x". **DO NOT include your name.**

Thank you for helping the SMM Food Bank not only feed the bodies of our neighbors in need, but also their minds!

We will add a birthday prayer card as a bookmark.

Connecting Father Koval, Pastor of St. Vladimir, MQA, and a Parish & Orphanage in Ukraine

Each month one of our PNUT days will be for an orphanage that Father Koval connects with and supports through his parish. He will be working to bring us letters and time to meet the children virtually. We are planning to have a family event that will allow us to "meet". We also plan to video our Christmas concerts, write about our traditions, and share those with the youth group and students in the orphanage. They will do likewise and share with us.

Most importantly, we will be sharing our faith.

Absences, Schoology, and PowerSchool

For daily absences, please refer to Schoology to learn what was covered in class and what homework was assigned. If able, have your child work on what he/she can get done with what resources and books are at home, rest and get better, and we will catch your child up once he/she gets back. Extensions for getting the work completed will be considered and students will get due dates for completion. Graded work will be entered with a zero along with the absent code in PowerSchool. Once turned in by the new due date, the grade will be replaced with the one earned.

If the family is going on an extended educational field trip, please take the books home with you before you leave on your trip. Then use Schoology to stay abreast of assignments as best you can. If your child will be out for an extended period of time due to illness, contact the office.

COVID Absences

PA Department of Education's protocol for positive COVID tests says that if you test positive stay home for 5 days, or more if you still have a fever. Mask for an additional 5 days upon returning to school. The school will prepare books and laptops for home use.


