

Reading Club

Reading Club is a group that, with a team effort, is competitive. The competition is diocesan, and the location is to be determined. A list of 10 novels is provided each school year and students are encouraged to read as many as they can over the summer and throughout the year! The novels are purchased by the school and students are assigned to read a number of novels to become experts on them. They generate questions about the novels and practice Q&A during after school reading club sessions. This helps them prepare for the competition. The club meets after school. Committing to reading team means committing to the after-school sessions, generating questions for practicing, and to the competition. The reading club moderators are Mrs. Frantz and Mrs. Kleckner.
