

## FACTS Financial Aid Application & Financial Aid


Families who want financial aid for the 2025-26 school year must have a completed financial aid application on file with FACTS. This includes the uploading and processing of the documents FACTS requires. Aid cannot be given without all documents showing "complete". Financial aid applications also have a fee determined by FACTS for processing the application. Until it is paid, the application is not verified/completed, and therefore no aid can be given until this step is completed.

**As a reminder: Applying for Financial Aid and Re-enrolling for the 2025-2026 school year are two different items to prepare for the upcoming school year. Please call the office if you have any questions.**

## May Crowning and Living Rosary

Congratulations to Hadassah Cardaro, our May Queen. May crowning at MQA will be on Thursday, May 15 at Mount Saint Peter Church at 1:15 pm. Second grade students as well as students from other grades will form the beads of the Living Rosary. Second grade students may change into their first communion attire at school following an early lunch. Buses will bring the students in grades 4-8 to Mount St. Peter. *Parents attending the service should park in the back lot in the diagonal parking spots and leave immediately after the service.*




